FROM THE OFFICE.....

Finger Print Scan & Dropping Off Your Child

Located at lobby desk is our fingerprinting scan system. Please be sure to scan your child in and out each day.

If your child is joining us for breakfast, please say goodbye at the top of the steps to the multipurpose room. A staff member will help your child transition to hang up their coat if necessary and get seated for breakfast. With the cooler transitional weather in the morning, please have your child dressed to play outside in the early morning. If his/her jacket or sweater is in the classroom when you arrive for breakfast, please go get it and hang it on the pegs in the multipurpose room. This assists us greatly in our transition outdoors after breakfast. It is difficult to escort each child individually to get a jacket from the classroom.

If your child is not joining us for breakfast, please take him/her to a teacher. Generally, the early morning staff and children are in one of two places - the hallway toy area or on the playground. Our staff members arrive at various times; if your child's own teacher and/or team member is not yet available, another staff member will welcome your child. If you arrive after 8:30, please take your child directly to his classroom. Please do not leave your child unattended in the hall or at the sign-in desk.

The art of saying “goodbye” is a little like jumping rope the double Dutch way. It is easy to lose your footing and get tangled up! Plan ahead for how you see separation happening. Plan a little extra time. Your child will take the clues from you. Be positive. Wait to say goodbye until you mean it. Once you have said goodbye to your child, it is time to go. If the transition is difficult, please feel free to call school and check on your child.

Safety

PLEASE do your part to ensure the safety of every child and Hope family. **Please do not use your cell phone while on the parking lot or in the building.** Drive slowly....under 10 miles per hour while on school property and be aware of pedestrian traffic. Also, please do not leave younger or older children unsupervised in your car. We ask that you lock your car and do not leave valuables in plain sight,

What Time is Breakfast?

Breakfast begins at 7:00 a.m. and ends at 8:00 a.m. If you are planning on your child joining us for breakfast, he/she should be seated at the breakfast table by 7:45 a.m. so they can be finished eating by 8:00. If you find you are running late, please make other arrangements for breakfast.

Photos of our Staff:

To assist families in learning the names of staff members, there will be photographs of each team member on the bulletin board just outside your child’s classroom. Please check the board routinely for classroom information, field trip information, school events, etc.

School Directory

A draft directory is available for review at the sign-in desk for you to verify that all of your information is listed correctly before distributing it to each school family. Please advise the office any time you have a change in your contact information (cell/work/home phone numbers, address, emergency contacts, email addresses, etc.). It is extremely important that we have current information on file to reach parents as needed.

The Honeywell Instant Alert is the system we use to notify our families of an emergency or weather-related situation. Maintaining the accuracy of your profile information is essential to be able to receive important information in a timely manner. All of our new families have been added or transferred from Infant Toddler into the system with just the basic information (student name, parents' names, home phone) and provided with an instruction sheet for accessing the system to update the contact phone numbers and preferred method of communication. All families are encouraged to log onto their personal profile to verify the information listed is current. The website is <https://instantalert.honeywell.com>; extra copies of the instruction sheet are located at the sign-in desk. On Monday, September 10, at 10:00 a.m., we will run a test alert.
